

## COMMITTEE FOR VOLUNTEER CARE TERMS OF REFERENCE

TYPE:Working Committee

**PURPOSE:**Volunteers are the heart of CORK and it is a responsibility of all parts of the organization to recruit new people.While the Committee for Volunteer Care will be also be a participant in recruiting people, it will be the leader in measures to make volunteers feel valued and eager to return.

## SPECIFIC AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY:

- 1. Develops measures to recognize volunteers' efforts and to make volunteers feel welcome
- 2. Develops and maintains subordinate group(s) to carry out such tasks as greeting volunteers at events, assisting new volunteers and preparing for social events
- 3. Advises the Executive on policies that would assist the recruitment and retention of volunteers
- 4. Pursues opportunities to recruit people and organizations to participate in CORK
- 5. Coordinates with staff and the Planning Group to recruit people with particular experience or qualifications
- 6. Obtains Executive Director concurrence for initiatives with financial implications

**COMPOSITION:**A minimum of three persons, of whom one shall be a Director but not necessarily the Chair. The Chair and members of the committee will be appointed by the Board. CORK staff should attend or be consulted prior to a meeting.

**TIMEFRAMES AND REPORTING:** The Committee shall meet periodically as its responsibilities should require and report semi-annually to the Board.
